2021 Annual Military Spending by Nation

*This number only reflects the U.S. Department of Defense budget. In reality, U.S. military spending is much higher and includes expenditures on nuclear weapons in the Department of Energy, plus the Department of Homeland Security, and other military spending, totaling \$1.25 trillion – meaning that the U.S. spends ~50% of total global military spending with only 4.5% of the world population.
