An innocent family of 10 were killed. We remember the Ahmadi family and the 9,000 to 17,000 drone assassination victims.


We hope this remembrance helps you to understand the pain, the death and terror we are inflicting on so many in the world.

We must acknowledge the U.S impact on the world. Below is a brief sketch of our destructive engagement with weapons sales. US militarism is hastening climate collapse, and is causing countless deaths and untold misery both home and abroad.

A few important key facts:

Weapons exports from the United States currently exceeds 137 billion dollars a year.

On March 18, 2022, Forbes reported,

“We’re #1: The U.S. Government is the World’s Largest Arms Dealer William Hartung Contributor”.

Some quick take aways:

“... from 2017 to 2021, the U.S. accounted for 39 percent of major arms deliveries worldwide, ...”

“...over twice what Russia transferred and nearly 10 times what China sent to its weapons clients.”

U.S weapons customers totaled 103 nations.

The top five world arms manufacturers are Lockheed Martin, Boeing, Northrop Grumman, Raytheon and General Dynamics, all US corporations.

“America dropped 26,171 bombs in 2016”. Nearly “3 bombs every hour, 24 hours a day”. From the Guardian.
